

KS1 Autumn Term 2019

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>We will follow the curriculum for all aspects of literacy including, spoken language, writing, reading, spelling and grammar.</p> <p>Our learning will take place through studying different text genres, fiction and non-fiction. As writers, we will: write labels; write lists; write captions; write instructions and present information.</p> <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will follow the curriculum for all aspects of numeracy. We will be using 'White Rose Maths' to support us in mastering different objectives. Once a week, we will follow an Active Maths program, which promotes learning through physical movement.</p>	<p>At Middleton Tyas School children in KS1 will be studying the same History topic of: 'Great and Ghastly Events'</p> 	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>As scientists, we will: identify and compare the suitability of materials, and how materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. We will ask questions and find out why the building materials used in Tudor times were one of the factors that enabled the Great Fire of London to spread so quickly.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We will continue to look at the importance of E-safety and the school's ICT rules. We will develop our skills in following instructions and learn how to program the Bee-Bots.</p>
<p><u>Art and Design</u></p> <p>We will produce our own artwork, developing and mastering different techniques. Jan Griffier's painting of the Great Fire of London will be our starting point. We will be designing, making and evaluating our own Tudor houses. Later in the term, we will roll our sleeves up and bake the biscuits mentioned in Samuel Pepys diary.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>We will immerse ourselves in the events of the Great Fire of London and like historians, we will ask questions and look for answers. After half term, we will research the history behind Bonfire Night. Finally, we will learn all about the race to space and make a timeline of the moon landing.</p> <p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will focus on our capital city of London and learn about famous buildings and other landmarks. We will also research famous residents and other popular tourist attractions.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>This is taught in line with the new Understanding Christianity series: 'How do we say 'thank you' for our beautiful world?' and 'Why does Christmas matter?' We will also be looking at this terms world faith of Judaism - What special festivals do Jews celebrate and why? Our Christian values this term are 'thankfulness' and 'trust'.</p>
<p><u>PSHCE</u></p> <p>Our PSHCE topic is 'All about me'. We will be using the SEAL (social and emotional aspects of learning) resources to support our learning.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>We will be building on a variety of different skills to support us when playing games and taking part in different activities. We are doing the following sports this term: gymnastics, dance and tag rugby.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Our work will follow the Music Express plan relevant to our age group.</p>
